NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

PART OF THE ALBERTA SERIES

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The preamble to RRS Part 4 and RRS 40 are changed to require a personal flotation device (PFD) to be worn at all times when afloat, except when changing clothing.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all classes.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online or onsite registration process.
- 2.3 Five or more boats of the same class registered by September 2, 2017 at 0855 will be scored as a fleet. All other boats will be scored using the current wind adjusted Portsmouth handicapping system.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Pre-Registered prior to August 26, 2017
 - Single handed Regatta only \$80.00
 - Double handed Regatta only \$90.00
 - Triple handed Regatta only \$110.00
- 3.2 Without Pre-Registration (e.g. Onsite or day-of)
 - Single handed Regatta only \$95.00
 - Double handed Regatta only \$105.00
 - Triple handed Regatta only \$125.00
- 3.3 Race Fee includes reception, breakfasts and lunches. Barbeque tickets (Sat & Sun) are \$20 each.

- 4.2 Twelve races are scheduled.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6 Venue

Racing will take place on the waters of Lake Wabamun, Alberta.

7 Courses

The courses to be sailed will be either Windward/Leeward or Triangle/Sausage.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 One race is required to constitute a series.
- 8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.3 When from 5 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be her total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.4 When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9 Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

10 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded based on the following numbers of boats per fleet:

2-5 boats	1 st place
6-9 boats	1 st & 2 nd places
10 or more boats	1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd places

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.

13 Rights to Use Name and Likeness

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this events in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the events without compensation.
