1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 RRS 40.1 applies and is amended so that it applies at all times while afloat. [DP][NP]
- 1.3 RRS Appendix T "Arbitration" will apply.
- 1.4 [DP] Protocols related to COVID-19 may be published at any time, state when they will take effect, and will state if they have the status of a rule.
- 1.5 A boat that sails with a sail number she is not registered with or received permission from the race committee to sail with will receive a 20% scoring penalty calculated as per RRS 44.3(c). The scoring penalty points will be added to the Net of the boat's race scores. This changes RRS 63.1 & Appendix A2.1 [NP]

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all dinghy and catamaran classes.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online registration process: https://wabamunsailingclub.com/regatta-events/#id=235&cid=1831&wid=1601&type=Cal
- 2.3 Five or more boats of the same class registered and paid by June 9, 2023 at 2200 will be scored as a fleet. All other boats will be scored using the current RYA Portsmouth time correction system.

3 Fees

- 3.2 In the case of event cancellation, all fees except for bank charges will be refunded.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board.

6 Venue

Racing will take place on the waters of Lake Wabamun, Alberta.

7 Courses

The courses to be sailed will be either Windward/Leeward or Triangle.

8 Scoring

- 8.1 One race is required to constitute a series.
- 8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 8.3 When from 5 to 7 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be her total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 8.4 Seven races are scheduled

9 Communication [DP]

- 9.1 The official notice board will be located located at the Wabamun Sailing Club. All postings required by the racing rules will be posted there.
- 9.2 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing, nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded based on the following numbers of boats per fleet:

2-5 boats 1st place

6-9 boats 1st & 2nd places 10 or more boats 1st, 2nd & 3rd places

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.

13 Rights to Use Name and Likeness

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the event without compensation.
