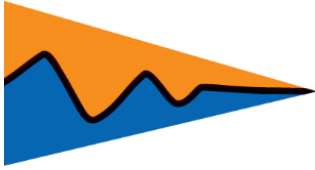

NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

This regatta is part of the Alberta Series --



The notation '**[DP]**' in a rule in the NOR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

[NP] denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

1 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Preamble to RRS Part 4 and RRS 40 is changed to require personal flotation devices (PFD's) to be worn at all times when afloat, except when changing clothing. **[DP]**
- 1.3 Boats that sail with a sail number other than the sail number they registered with at the regatta will receive a one time 20% scoring penalty. The scoring penalty points will be added to the total of the boat's race scores.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all dinghy and catamaran classes.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online or onsite registration process.
- 2.3 Five or more boats of the same class registered by August 31, 2019 at 0855 will be scored as a fleet. All other boats will be scored using the current wind adjusted Portsmouth time correction system.

3 Fees

- 3.1 Pre-Registered prior to 2400, August 26, 2019
 - Single handled Regatta only \$70.00
 - Double handled Regatta only \$110.00
- 3.2 Without Pre-Registration (Tuesday August 27 and after)
 - Single handled Regatta only \$90.00
 - Double handled Regatta only \$130.00

Race Fee includes breakfasts and welcome reception.

There are limited "day of" lunches and barbeque tickets available if not pre-purchased (Saturday & Sunday bag lunch, Monday lunch on shore after racing). Please purchase in advance to guarantee your meals.

There is a discount for meals purchased on-line before midnight Monday, August 26

4.2 Twelve races are scheduled.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

6 Venue

Racing will take place on the waters of Lake Wabamun, Alberta.

7 Courses

The courses to be sailed will be either Trapezoid, Windward/Leeward or Triangle.

8 Scoring

8.1 One race is required to constitute a series.

8.2 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 When from 5 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be her total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8.4 When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

9 Radio Communication [DP]

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing, nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

10 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded based on the following numbers of boats per fleet:

2-5 boats	1st place
6-9 boats	1st & 2nd places
10 or more boats	1st, 2nd & 3rd places

11 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance. The organizing authority does not accept any responsibility for verifying that a boat has valid third-party liability insurance.

13 Rights to Use Name and Likeness

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this events in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the events without compensation.
